

## Cancellation of Acceptance Postgraduate Courses

Once you have accepted an offer to study at the University of Huddersfield, you will be able to cancel your acceptance within 14 days, without giving any reason.

The cancellation period will expire, either 14 days after the date on which you accepted the offer, which is the date on which your contract with the University began, or the date you enrol at the University if this is earlier. If you have paid any fees during this cancellation period, they will be refunded to you. The right to cancel is a statutory right under the United Kingdom's [Consumer Contracts \(Information, Cancellation and Additional Charges\) Regulations 2013](#).

Please note that if you have accepted an offer for PGCE, there are DfE Apply regulations that both the University and applicants must take into account when making any changes to an application to study. The DfE Apply website has guidance on making changes and any actions you need to make or be aware of. Please ensure that you refer to the [DfE Apply website](#) for further advice and follow their guidance where this applies.

Your statutory right of cancellation does not affect your right to withdraw from the University at other times and you should speak to the University's Student Recruitment Team if you would like to withdraw outside of the 14 day cancellation period.
