The application process for exchange students

Exchange agreement

If you want to become an exchange student at Huddersfield Business School (HBS), a student exchange agreement between your university and HBS is required. Please contact the international office of your home university to find out if such an agreement exists or check our list of partner universities for more details.

The agreement allows students to earn credits at HBS and transfer them back to their home university, while being exempt from paying any tuition fees.

If there is no agreement in place, but you are interested in coming to Huddersfield, please raise queries with Marlene Lieske M.S.Lieske@hud.ac.uk

Exchange nomination

If there is an agreement, apply to your international office for an exchange placement. Your home university can then formally nominate you for a study abroad at HBS. The nomination deadline for the autumn term is 15/05, and for the spring term 15/11. Application is possible until 31/05 for the autumn term and until 30/11 for the spring term.

The required level of English language skills

Nominated students should have a good level of written and spoken English to ensure that they can follow lectures and complete written and oral assignments. We recommend an English level of at least CEF B2 or IELTS 6/7.

At HBS we have Learning Development Tutors, who support you with your academic writing and the development of your academic skills.

Visa information

If you're studying at the University of Huddersfield for less than six months, you can do this as a visitor. Many students (including those from the European Union and other eligible countries) won't need a visa for courses lasting less than six months.

You can apply for a short-term study visa to study English language in the UK. This visa is for English language courses lasting longer than 6 months and up to 11 months.

Health insurance

Students studying for less than 6 months

If your stay in the UK is 6 months or less, you do not need to pay the immigration health surcharge. If you have a valid EU or Switzerland-issued EHIC or are a Norwegian citizen with a valid Norwegian passport, you can access medically necessary treatment during your stay.

If you're a citizen of Iceland or Liechtenstein, you may have to pay for any NHS healthcare you receive. Any treatment that you need to pay for will be charged at 150% of the national NHS rate.

You should buy insurance to cover your healthcare as you would if visiting another non-EU country.
